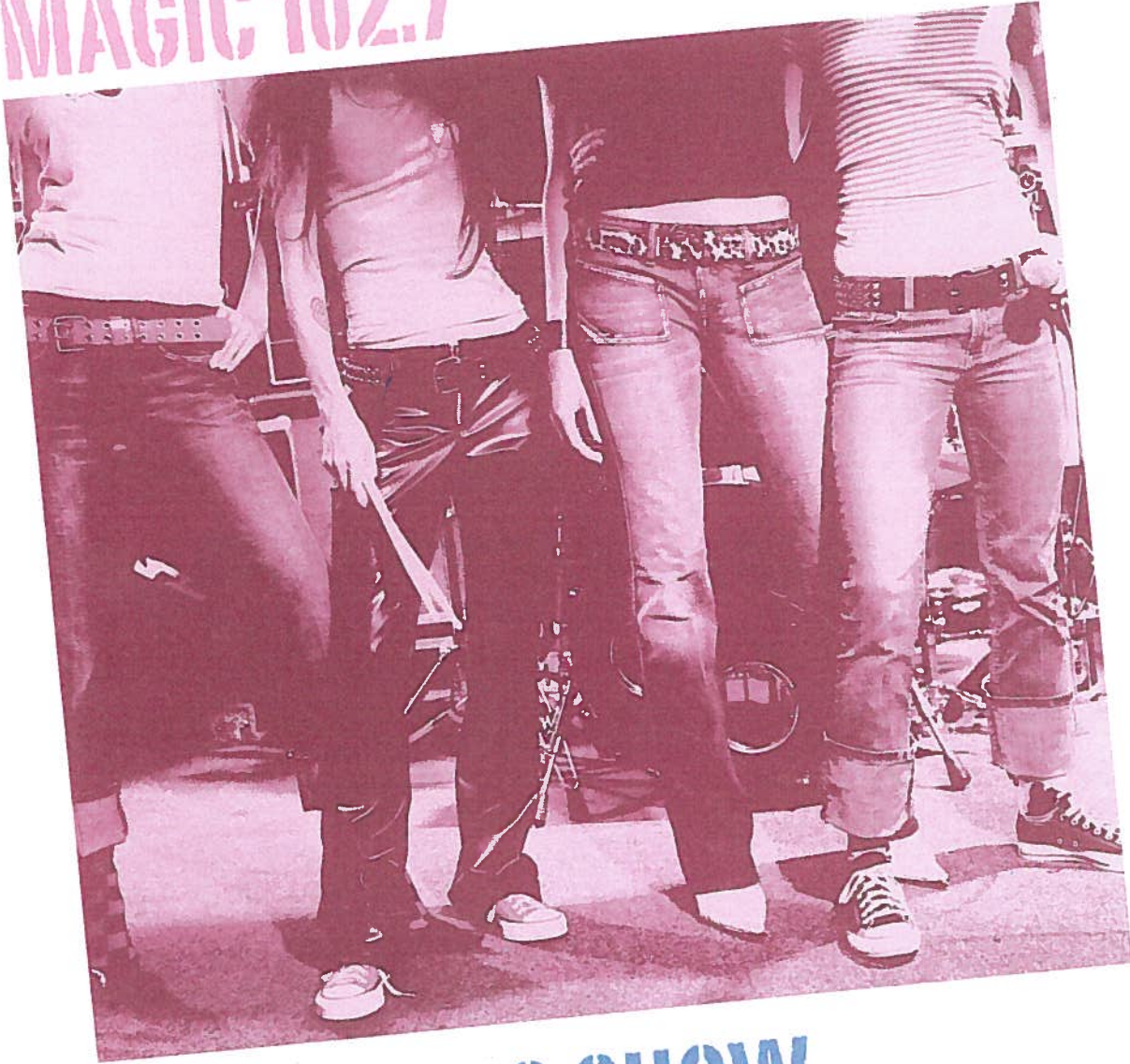

Programme Description

We look to introduce various musical and theatrical programmes for public primary, middle and senior schools during the school day, lunch breaks and after school.

Music Programmes

- Lunchtime primary school music programmes will focus on the teaching of Orff instruments (xylophones and glockenspiels), keyboards, and recorders.
- Middle school lunch and afterschool music programmes will focus on DJing, Emceeing, Keyboarding, Voice, Music Technology (production, recording and sound reinforcement)
- High school music programmes will be delivered during the school day, focusing on voice, vocal production, arranging and performance, to supplement GSCCE music curriculum requirements. DJing and Emceeing will be offered as a lunchtime club.

Theatrical Programmes

Afterschool primary and middle school programmes will emphasize:

- Expression through drama
- Enunciation

- Stage posture and presence
- Speaking with confidence
- Dramatic skits and soliloquies

Teen Radio Show

A senior school afterschool programme designed to increase expression and literacy through broadcasting.

Musical Programme Objectives

Theatrical Programme Objectives

- To increase oral and expression skills
- To expose students to drama
